## Phase News



What a lovely sunny couple of weeks we've had in EYFS! The children have enjoyed starting our new book 'Jack and the flum flum tree'. They are enjoying role playing being doctors and helping granny to feel better. In Maths we have been learning about capacity, ordering containers from least full to most full. The children have written some super 'get well soon' letters to Granny showing off their phonics skills and sentence writing. Thank you for your continued support with reading at home. The children are really enjoying their phonics sessions and it is important that they are continuing to read daily at home. We are looking forward to seeing you at Sport's Day next week.



Thank you to all those who were able to support our Key stage 1 Sport's Day. The children and staff had a really lovely time and we are incredibly proud of our children. We especially enjoyed the Male Staff potato race!

The children in Year 2 have been finding out and creating leaflets about Delamare Forest. They have used the Chrome books to do some research and find out lots of information which they then used to write their leaflets. We are now really excited about our trip in a couple of weeks time.

Year 1 has been learning about numbers up to 100. They have been using tens and ones apparatus, number lines and tens frames to make different amounts. They have also been spotting patterns on a 100 square so that they can locate numbers speedily. All children in Y1, who have been in school, have completed their phonic screening check. We are so proud of them all, thank you so much for all your hard work at home in helping prepare them to use special friends, Fred talk, read the word. We will now be focusing on applying these sounds accurately in our writing. In the afternoon, children have been using a variety of sketching pencils to draw Harlech Castle in the style of John Sell Cotman. Finally, we have been making special cards for special people in our lives.





Thank you to all who were able to support our Sports Day last week. The children made us all incredibly proud and a great time was had by all. Although this week has been a hot one, we have had the most enjoyable week in school. In English, the children are in the process of planning a 'lost' narrative. They have lots of fantastic ideas and have really built upon their writers knowledge. In D.T. the children are designing and making a moving monster using pneumatics. The children are showing great team working skills and demonstrating their perseverance and problem solving skills. Well done to our year 4 children who have now completed their multiplication check. We know how hard you have all worked on learning your times tables and we are very proud of you all. Just a reminder that the children should be learning the final column of the year 3/4 spelling list this half term.



We've had a lovely couple of weeks in the sunshine in Year 5 and 6 and have been enjoying our topic work immensely. In English, we have been reading the book 'Holes' by Louis Sachar and have written a letter home to 'Mom' about Stanley's first few days in Camp Green Lake. It's a fantastic story and it's been great to see the children's enjoyment. In Science, we have been investigating electrical circuits and finding out what happens when we add more components to a series circuit. In our History work, we have also been finding out about Britain's involvement in the Slace trade with the USA and how that has impacted Britain today. The children have been really thoughtful and mature in their responses to this work.

Just a reminder for Year 6 parents that we need baby photos please asap. The first event in the leavers' programme coming up is this Thursday 22nd June when we will be enjoying a 'Big Play Out' in the school grounds in the evening 6:30-9pm. This will be a chance to enjoy a huge play out with their friends before they leave us for high school. Please make sure children have eaten tea before they come, but they will be provided with some snacks and drinks during the evening. Further information will follow shortly.





We have thoroughly enjoyed the two sports days we have so far hosted at school, we hope that all the children in year 1, 2, 3 and 4 have created memories that will last a life time. Thank you for all the support from everyone who came to cheer on a support the children in all of their events. There are still two sports day left (EYFS on Friday 23rd and Y5/6 on Friday 30th) we hope that they run just as smoothly and welcome your support again on those Friday mornings.

The long awaited return of the famous Town Sports Event is just around the corner, selection this year has been incredibly hard with many talented KS2 children sadly missing out (if we could take you all we would!). Town Sports is on Wednesday 21st of June at the boys school who will be welcoming in visitors form 3:45pm, yous support is greatly appreciated.

Congleton Youth Orchestra are opening their doors to aspiring orchestral musicians on <u>Saturday 13th May 2023</u>.

We cater for all, from complete beginners; those who have started playing an instrument in school; to established musicians.

The event will run between 9:30am and 12pm, with two time slots:

- 9:30-11am For musicians playing for 1 year or more.
- 11am-12pm For complete beginners.

First established in November 1994, the Congleton Youth Orchestra gives young people from Congleton, and the surrounding areas the opportunity to learn, play and perform music in an orchestral setting.

The Orchestra has both a Senior Orchestra (Grade 4+) and an Intermediate Orchestra (Grade 0-3), and provision for beginner players restarting in September 2023. The Orchestra performs a concert at the end of each term, which are generally held in Congleton Town Hall.

The Orchestra meets each Saturday morning during term time at Trinity Methodist Church, Wagg Street, Congleton, CW12 4BA. All our groups are taught by our experienced instrumental staff and volunteers, our staff are all Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checked.
